What to prepare for?

Creative Personal Statement

- explaining why you choose the Social Design discipline (can include images)
- one A4 paper (2 pages) maximum
- put your name, application number on the top right-hand corner of your statement

AND

Design-related Portfolio:

- should include a wide range of projects (or social projects) from sketching, drawing, photography, to the design outcomes of your specialism
- showing the project development process is more important than just the final artworks

AND/OR

Other Learnings Portfolio:

- should include your personal learning projects and/or school projects that demonstrate your interests and commitment in the social design field.
- showing your personal learning experience is more important than just the exam results

Remark: You may select your artworks or projects that are more related to the social and cultural spectrum (e.g.: social enterprise proposals, activity proposals for the community, etc.)

***Creative personal statement and Portfolio -- Maximum of 30 A4 pages not exceeding 20Mb submitted in PDF format**

Interview

- Written test in English, knowing your aptitude and commitment to Social Design
- Group interview to check your communication and critical skills
- Q & A session to clarify expectations
