Portfolio Guidelines (PDF format)

- Make a cover page to introduce yourself, your background and your skill sets in no more than 150 words.
- Include a **mix of 7-10** of your best design and expressive /artistic projects using a **variety of different media and approaches**. Keep similar projects and repeated images to a minimum. Include examples of hand sketching and hand drawing. Objects and models should be photographed. For **each project**, show **3 – 4 images** highlighting working process and final outcome that can best explain your ideas and the how you reach your final design or art work.
- All projects should be clearly labeled with the following information whenever possible:
 - Title, format and size / dimensions
 - Purpose of the project and intended target audience
 - No links or QR codes to external media in your portfolio
 - Clearly specify the Class or program in which you created the work, whether school or extra-curricular programs. If you made the work outside of school or structured programs, please include, "personal project."
- Maximum of **30 A4 pages not exceeding 20Mb submitted in PDF format**.
- Display works in **landscape** orientation.
- Include the following **explanations for at least 2** of your selected projects:
 - A 50-word or less description Project development process: Research, sketches, etc.
 - Personal insights / key lesson(s) learned

Tips:

- Organize your works. **Label** each project **clearly** and consider the order they should be viewed. Ensure your **name** and **application number** are visible on your work in case they get separated;
- Any other details may be informed by email. Please **keep your email address accurate and updated** in your application record.
